Food Service Establishment Fats, Oil, and Grease (FOG) Wastewater Discharge Permit

Instructions to Complete

FOG Discharge Permit Application Form

SECTION A – GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Enter facility's official or legal name. Do not use a DBA, "Doing Business As."
2. Provide the physical location of the facility that is applying for a discharge permit.
3. Provide a daytime telephone number .
4. Provide the name of the owner or designated facility contact person. The owner or designated facility contact person would be the person thoroughly familiar with the operation of the facility who can be contacted by our inspector. This person will receive correspondence, including the discharge permit, from the District.
5. Provide a business address if different then physical location of facility.

SECTION B – FACILITY OPERATIONAL CHARACTERISTICS

SECTION C – TREATMENT

1. Choose the best description of treatment on facility site.

Grease Interceptor – a **device located underground and outside** a food service facility designed to collect, contain, or remove food wastes and grease from the waste stream while allowing the balance of the liquid waste to discharge to the sewer system by gravity.

Grease Trap – a **device located in a food service facility or under a sink** designed to collect, contain, or remove wastes and grease from the waste stream while allowing the balance of the liquid waste to discharge to the sewer system by gravity.

SECTION D – PERMIT FEE

This section will be completed by the authorized district inspector during the first visit to your food service establishment. A check for the indicated amount must accompany the application form mailed to the district.
