DUTIES: Principal Engineer - Under the general direction of the Assistant Director of

Engineering, supervises the work of engineering personnel; provides professional engineering expertise; develops and manages major Capital Improvement Program projects and overall program; works closely with staff implementing infrastructure Operation upgrades, repairs, replacements: interfaces with governmental agencies, developers. contractors, and engineering consultants; prepares various reports, requests for proposals, contracts, etc., necessary for implementing various water,

recycled water, and wastewater related projects.

Senior Engineer - Under the general direction of the Principal Engineer, performs highly responsible civil engineering work; executes and manages complex engineering and Capital Improvement Program projects; works closely with Operations staff implementing infrastructure upgrades, repairs, and replacements; oversees consultants, contractors and subordinate staff in project execution; prepares various reports, requests for proposals, contracts, etc., necessary for implementing various water, recycled water, and wastewater related projects.

Both jobs require the incumbent to utilize considerable independence in selecting work methods and procedures. Duties and responsibilities are carried out with considerable independence within the framework of established policies and procedures. The work is complex and involves significant accountability and independent decision-making responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or

university in civil engineering or related science. Masters degree in a related engineering or management major from an accredited university is desirable.

Must be a registered Professional Civil Engineer in the State of California. Must possess a valid California driver's license and maintain a safe driving record.
