


Purpose

- State law requires the District to have a water shortage contingency plan
- Update to current Water Shortage Contingency Plan
 - Proposed Ordinance
 - May need to implement in near future
 - Allocations
- Integrate with rate structure
 - Avoid mandatory watering days
 - Allow customers to manage their own budgeted water
 - Progression of targeted water reductions



Foundation for Stages

- Target over allocation customers first
- Further incentivize conservation
- Penalize customers violating water use ordinances
- Ensure timely response to future water shortage events
- Possible stage implementation triggers
 - State calls to action
 - Regulatory mandated actions
 - Supply allocations
 - System/supply emergency
 - Natural disaster
- Outreach for implementing stages
