Moulton Niguel Water District (MNWD) is dedicated to providing reliable and cost-effective water and recycled water services, and wastewater treatment for our customers. That commitment is exemplified through the high-quality service and exceptional staff who operate 24/7 to protect the infrastructure that delivers and stores our valuable water resources and treats all wastewater in an environmentally responsible manner.

Have you seen us in your community? We may be working on a number of different infrastructure improvement projects. One particular area where there has been increased activity is MNWD's Valve Replacement Program. Many of our valves are more than 25 years old and require replacement to ensure that they will operate as needed.



What's a Valve and Why Do They Need to be Replaced?

A valve is a critical piece of equipment that helps support the transportation of water. The District has approximately 21,000 valves throughout our service area that are primarily used to isolate sections of pipe in the event of planned or emergency repairs and connections. In 2015, we began to identify key valves throughout our distribution system that need to be replaced to improve water reliability to our customers and protect the infrastructure that helps deliver water and recycled water service to our customers. Operations Center Consolidation and Improvement Project Update

Another key infrastructure improvement project is the District's Operations Center Consolidation and Improvement project. Our existing facilities require significant rehabilitation and upgrades from more than 40 years of use in serving the public. This project focuses on performing critical improvements to our current operations center while also consolidating all operations into a single site in Laguna Hills. 
