### **How Else Can Moulton Niguel Help?**

To check for leaks in your home, you first need to determine whether you're wasting water and then identify the source of the leak. Here are some tips for finding leaks:

- Take a look at your water usage during a colder month. If a family of four exceeds 12,000 gallons per month, you may have a leak.
- Check your water meter before and after a two-hour period when no water is being used. If the meter changes at all, you probably have a leak.
- Identify toilet leaks by placing a toilet dye strip in the toilet tank. If any color shows up in the bowl after 10 minutes, you have a leak. We offer FREE dye strips for you to take home and test!
- **Examine faucet gaskets and pipe fittings for any water on the outside of the pipe to check for surface leaks.**
