
Moulton Niguel Water District: Committed to Serving Our Customers

Operating one of the state's most successful water recycling programs, Moulton Niguel reuses more than 2 billion gallons of water every year.

Recycled water meets about 25 percent of the district's water demands, reduces our dependence on imported water, and provides our customers with reliable access to water. Our recycled water program has conserved billions of gallons of water and helped thousands of customers save money. Thank you to all of our customers of the past 50 years who have made the switch to recycled water, and to those customers today who are continuing to propel our recycled water program to further success!
