### PROJECT LOCATION:

Mission Viejo

### PROJECT SCOPE:

The project installs approximately 1,000 linear feet of 12-inch PVC pipe along Medical Center Road in the City of Mission Viejo. The project also installs a new pressure reducing station, service connections, and related valve replacements. Several of the valve replacements in the project were originally part of the 2017-18 Valve Replacements, Contract No. 2017.006 and were added to this project to minimize future impacts to the area.

The project contains both public and private improvements. The District serves as the managing agency for construction of both the public and private facilities, in close coordination with Mission Hospital Regional Medical Center (MHRMC) and the City of Mission Viejo. MHRMC will reimburse the District for the cost of constructing the private facilities, which they will own.

Construction documents for the Mission Hospital 750-Zone Service project were prepared by AKM Consulting Engineers.
