


The Watershed Approach


- Landscape with our Climate




Mediterranean Climate Zones

Soil & Water Work Together



WATER - INFILTRATED!

Rainwater is:

- pH neutral
- Has no damaging salts
- No antibacterials
 (chloramine, fluoride,
 chlorine) to damage
 soil organisms.

Healthy Soil:

- Infiltrates
- Cleans and filters
- Holds water stable








Seasonal rainwater capture Redirected to landscape

Slow Spread & Sink Water







