## Back to School Water Education

School has started up again and there are some great educational programs to support our local students and school districts. In partnership with the Orange County Coastkeeper, we offer a two-day program to teach students about our local watersheds and the importance of keeping them clean and free from pollution. This two-day program includes an in-class presentation and a field trip to a local watershed to conduct water quality experiments.



Moulton Niguel also participates in Project WET, a national program to provide teachers and administrators with tools to educate students about environmental subjects, including water! This summer, in partnership with the Water Education Foundation, Moulton Niguel hosted a free training session that provided water education materials to K-12 educators and after school educational professionals to incorporate into their classrooms.
