

Rainwater Harvesting Program Terms and Conditions

Please review the Terms and Conditions and Program Requirements sections; your NatureScape Application signature will opt the applicant in for this additional rebate. Your check will come from Environmental Incentives, a contractor providing technical and administrative support for this effort.

By accepting payment, the participant agrees to follow the requirements and Terms & Conditions set forth below.

- Participant agrees to waive and release Environmental Incentives, Monarch Environmental Inc., Tree of Life Nursery,, Moulton Niguel Water District (“District”), and their respective officers, consultants and employees from, and agree to indemnify, defend and hold Environmental Incentives, Monarch Environmental Inc., Tree of Life Nursery, the District, and their respective officers, agents and employees harmless from, any and all claims and causes of action, damages, injuries or other liabilities related to or arising out of the installation, improvement, alteration, use, maintenance or repair of the rainwater harvesting feature or cistern, or any other activities in connection with the Rainwater Harvesting Incentive Program.
- The District’s staff will verify that the landscape feature or cistern has been installed and that it is connected to a downspout for the appropriate roof area; then use this information to determine whether payments shall be applied to completed work. The District will not be responsible for the installation, operation or maintenance of improvements and provides no warranty as to performance of improvements. The District will not be responsible for any damage caused by the installation or operation of the improvements.
- The District may share information with Environmental Incentives and other contractors required to process payments and tax documentation, including, but not limited to: W-9 forms, NatureScape landscape designs, and project information, and imagery. Participants receiving \$600 or greater in a single calendar year are required to fill out a W9 and will be issued a 1099 form. It is up to the participant to determine their individual tax situation.
- Photography and information from the participant’s project may be used in communications related to this program. Participant’s address will not be published.

Program Requirements

- 1) Customer must apply for the NatureScape program and submit a W9.
- 2) Customer must install a landscape feature or cistern per their NatureScape landscape design.
- 3) Customer must have gutters around the perimeter of the designated roof area or install gutters at their own cost.
- 4) Customer must purchase and install materials to connect the downspout to the feature or cistern.
- 5) Cisterns must either have enough volume capacity to store the minimum rain harvest volume or all cistern overflow must infiltrate into adjacent landscaping.
- 6) Landscape feature or cistern overflows cannot be directed over a septic tank, to the building foundation or neighboring properties.
